Commissary Officials Respond To Beef Concerns

Officials at the Defense Commissary Agency are closely monitoring the ever-changing situation involving a case of bovine spongiform encephalopathy also known as "mad cow" disease, identified Dec. 23 in a single cow in Washington state. According to DeCA officials no beef in any of its commissaries worldwide has been involved in a recall. Investigators have determined that the recalled meat went to a few commercial markets in Alaska, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, Oregon, California, Nevada, Washington state and Guam. DeCA officials stress that no commissaries received any of those shipments. As always, customers who wish to return commissary products for a full refund may do so without question. Health Alert For Bottled Beverages

Military medical officials advise personnel in Europe to be alert to possible tampering of plastic beverage bottles including water, juices and milk. Recent reports from Italy indicate someone injecting ammonia, bleach-like solutions or soap-based solutions into plastic beverage bottles using a hypodermic needle just below the bottle cap. Beware Of Winter Driving Danger

Driving in Europe can be challenging, especially in winter conditions. Drivers often fail to recognize the deadliest danger of all winter driving - black ice or clear water that has frozen on dark roads. It usually forms below overpasses, on bridges and in areas surrounded by trees.

MPS Requires Correct Customs Form

Are you using your Military Postal System privileges and mailing letters and packages? Post office personnel remind patrons to use their APO return address and to fill out a customs form. Use PS Form 2976, the small green form, for small boxes and packages containing four or less items. Use PS Form 2976-A, the large white form, for larger boxes and packages containing more than four items.
