Power Outages Affect Patch Barracks

Power outages on Patch Barracks are planned Jan. 16 and 17 due to necessary preventative maintenance on the main power cable from Stuttgart to Patch Barracks. Buildings affected include 2202, 2207, 2212 to 2214, 2300 to 2325, 2329 to 2333, 2337 to 2343, 2345 to 2347, 2349, 2350, 2353, 2356, 2357, 2359, 2360, 2362, 2363, 2366, 2368, 2370 to 2375, 2379, 2381, 2383, 2384, 2386, 2390, 2393, 2395, 2398, 2399 and 2457.

The first major outage Jan. 16 will take place at 7 a.m., with an earlier outage occurring at 5:30 a.m. to accommodate community operations on buildings 2300, 2337 to 2339, 2366, 2345 and 2347. On Jan. 17 a power outage will occur at 7 a.m. for all buildings listed. Outages could last up to two hours, depending on the facility. U.S. Presidential Primaries Scheduled

Voters should submit an SF76 Federal Post Card Application now to states holding presidential primaries in February and March. **February primaries** will be held in Arizona, Delaware, Missouri, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia and Utah. **March primaries** will be held in California, Connecticut, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Mississippi, New York, Ohio, Rhode Island, Texas, Vermont and Washington.

Annual OHA Survey Available Online

The Department of Defense Per Diem Travel and Transportation Allowance Committee has made the annual Overseas Housing Allowance Survey available on the Internet.

Service members who reside in privately leased quarters overseas and receive an OHA should complete the survey each year. Respondents will need records of utility and maintenance expenses for the last 12 months.

Those who have lived off post less than 12 months should average utility expenses.

The survey will issue a "ticket number" allowing service members to complete the survey in more than one session. The survey is available at www.milsurveys.com/OHA until Jan. 31.

PCS/Pre-separation Briefing Planned

The next scheduled briefing for permanent change of station/pre-separation information is Jan. 28 at 1 p.m. in Patch Barracks building 2318, room 4. Service members and civilians departing within the next five months should attend.

Events, Functions Require FP Plan

A force protection assessment plan should be completed for all off-post official and U.S.-sponsored events. Unofficial events held off-post involving 50 or more individuals also require a force protection plan. Family, Medical Leave Entitlement Info

Under the Family and Medical Leave Act of 1993, most Federal employees are entitled to a total of 12 work weeks of unpaid leave during any 12-month period for the birth of a child; placement of a child with the employee for adoption or foster care; care of a spouse, son, daughter or parent with a serious health condition; or a serious health condition that prevents the employee from performing the essential functions of their position.

An employee must provide notice of intent to take family and medical leave not less than 30 days before leave is to begin or, in emergencies, as soon as possible. An agency may request medical certification for FMLA leave taken to care for an employee's spouse, son, daughter or parent who has a serious health condition or for the serious health condition of the employee. Dog Owners: Remember The Rules

According to the 6th Area Support Group policy, Administrative Instructions for Control of Pets, all dog owners will ensure their dog is on a leash at all times while outside multi-apartment dwellings (this includes stairwells) or individual housing units on military installations. The dog will be under the supervision of an individual old enough to control it under any situation (at least twelve years old).

Dogs will not be walked or exercised in any playground area located in government housing or sport/baseball fields. All fecal matter must be picked up (cats and dogs) and disposed of immediately, to include the Kelley Barracks pet run and exercise area. The dog-fecal containers, Robi Dog, or other type containers located throughout the installations will be used at all times. Advise installation coordinators when containers are filled or not being used.

Report Suspected Espionage Incidents

Community members can help prevent subversion and espionage by guarding against the collection efforts of foreign intelligence services. Watch for persons attempting to gain information about military missions, activities, equipment, facilities or personnel using unsolicited letters or e-mail. Remember Your Mail When Departing

For those preparing to move away from the community, take leave for 30 days or go TDY for an extended period of time, don't forget about your mail. Visit the community or unit mailroom and fill out a DD Form 2258, Temporary Disposition of Mail.

Dependent parents or parents in-law who reside with active-duty or retired military sponsors in Europe may use military treatment facilities on a space-available basis. However, dependent parents are not eligible for Tricare Prime, Standard, Extra or Tricare For Life.

Parcels being mailed via the Intra-Theater Delivery System must be taken to the post office for processing. Items sent via IDS cannot be insured, certified or registered. The customer must pay for these special services, to include the postage at the local zone rate. Do not send high-value items through IDS because they cannot be insured or registered.

Also, envelopes and parcels sent using IDS can be forwarded to any European APO AE address and selected APOs worldwide. However, mail cannot be forwarded to a U.S. address, an economy address in Germany or an international address without the customer paying the appropriate rate of postage to these destinations. .
