The Department of Defense Per Diem Travel and Transportation Allowance Committee has made the annual Overseas Housing Allowance Survey available on the Internet.

Service members who reside in privately leased quarters overseas and who receive an OHA should complete the survey each year. Respondents will need records of utility and maintenance expenses for the last 12 months. Those who have lived off post fewer than 12 months should average utility expenses.
