Tax Office Opens On Kelley Barracks

The Stuttgart Tax Center will hold a grand opening ceremony Feb. 2, 9 a.m., and opens for business at 10 a.m. in Kelley Barracks building 3312. Center hours are Mondays to Fridays, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Appointments are recommended for those with more than basic tax returns - including owning a home, rental property and state taxes. Walk-ins are seen on a first-come, first-serve basis.

When visiting the Tax Center, remember to bring your U.S. military identification card, Social Security cards for yourself and dependents, a bank routing form for direct deposit, tax forms including W-2s, 1099s and other applicable forms, a copy of last year's return, and, if claiming daycare expenses, an employee identification number of the daycare provider. Report Any Suspicious Packages

Community members need to be aware of suspicious mail and packages. Characteristics to look for include an unknown place of origin, no return address, an excessive amount of postage, threatening messages, an unusual size, oily stains or powder, incorrect spelling of common words, differing return address and postmarks and odors including almond, dried grass or peach.

Use Checklist To Fight Terrorism

Instruct family members and associates not to provide strangers with information about you or your family. Do not give unnecessary personal details to information collectors and restrict personal data when using the Internet. Be alert to strangers who are on government installations for no apparent reason. Report all suspicious persons loitering, vary daily routines to avoid habitual patterns and be cautious about giving out travel plans or security measures and procedures.
