Influenza Vaccination Program Works

Only ten active-duty Soldiers have been diagnosed with influenza in U.S. Army, Europe, during this flu season. Senior leaders credit the low number of cases to a comprehensive vaccination campaign plan, which emphasizes the importance of medical readiness and a protected community. For the second year in a row USAREUR leads the Army in ensuring Soldiers and their families are protected against influenza. With a 93-percent immunization rate, USAREUR has exceeded the Army Surgeon General's goal and is demonstrating the highest percentage rate of immunized Soldiers of all Army major commands.

The flu season in Europe routinely runs from December through April, and individuals not yet immunized would benefit by receiving the shot. Everyone who is eligible, including children and adolescents, should get vaccinated against the flu. For concerns regarding health care in the Stuttgart community call the clinic commander, Lt. Col. The operator must show a current identification card, rental contract in their name and, if applicable, a copy of leave or temporary duty orders. AAFES personnel will post gasoline coupon purchases to the rental contract. The amount of fuel authorized is based on the motor size or the capacity of the vehicle.
