Award Ceremony Salutes 6th ASG

The 6th Area Support Group received a Special Merit Award for the community showing the most improvement in 2003 at the Combined Federal Campaign awards ceremony Feb. 27 in Heidelberg. Forty percent of potential donors in Army Europe participated with the average gift increasing from \$101 in 2002 to \$123 in 2003. While deployments in support of Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Iraqi Freedom reduced the donor pool by nearly 33 percent, total contributions were only affected by 15 percent.
