Trash Recycling Can Create Savings

The Stuttgart military community has increased the amount of waste it recycles in the last nine years from 10 percent to 39 percent. Although this is a significant achievement, more improvement is needed. Trash container inspections reveal that a large amount of recyclable materials are still not being separated.

Waste disposal costs are very high and the U.S. government is charged for every kilogram of material that goes into the trash containers. Community members are encouraged to separate trash by using the green and yellow recycling containers located throughout the community. Beware Of Suspicious Packages

Community members need to be aware of suspicious mail and packages. Characteristics to look for include an unusual or unknown place of origin, no return address, an excessive amount of postage, an abnormal or unusual size, oily stains or powder, incorrect spelling of common words, and peculiar odors such as almond, dried grass or peach.

Never touch or move a suspicious package or letter and wash hands immediately if you suspect the package may be contaminated. Immediately report incidents by calling the Stuttgart Military Intelligence Office at 421-2206/civ. 0711-729-2206.
