Volunteer For A Safer Neighborhood

The continuing concerns about terrorism include maintaining increased security awareness in military communities, especially in housing areas. One way residents can make a difference and help protect their community is to volunteer for the Safe Neighborhood Awareness Program.

SNAP volunteers are trained to serve as the "eyes and ears" of the community and help keep the focus on security by walking through their neighborhood. If they see something that appears suspicious, they report it to the military police. Any U.S. identification holder over the age of 15 (when partnered with an adult) is eligible to perform this important community service. Hours are flexible and volunteers can earn incentives including discount coupons and trips.

SNAP training will be held April 14 and 28, 10 a.m., in the Robinson Barracks Entertainment Center, located in building 168. Area and building coordinators from Robinson Barracks are welcome to attend. Other coordinators should attend training on their respective installations. U.S. Army, Europe, will not process, store or send classified information on non-secure telecommunications systems including computer networks, fax machines, modems, telephones and radios. Use of official Department of Defense telecommunications systems constitutes user consent to information systems security monitoring.

Commanders will ensure that official DoD telephone directories display the security notice on the front cover or prominently in the general information section; DD Forms 2056 are affixed to telephones and fax machines, including secure telephones; a computer log-on security notice is on all computer systems; and new personnel receive a briefing on telecommunications security.
