Vaccine Dosage Changes Temporarily

Due to a production shortfall of the Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine, military treatment facilities will follow Centers for Disease Control guidelines for the administration of this immunization to children. All medical facilities will temporarily provide two doses of the vaccine to children rather than the usual four doses.

Additional dosages are expected to be available later this summer when full production by the manufacturer is resumed. The vaccine, commonly known as Prevnar, protects against illnesses such as meningitis and blood infections, caused by one type of bacteria.
