## Summer Safety Campaign Begins May 1

The 2004 Summer Safety Campaign is about to begin, and its success depends on all of us. As summer arrives and community members look forward to warm days, special preparations are required to combat the unique hazards associated with this season. Areas requiring increased emphasis include water activities safety, vehicle safety, alcohol and substance abuse prevention, recreation activities, and preventing heat injuries.

The danger of heat injuries is significant, and training personnel to recognize and prevent heat injuries is essential. Every year, someone in the European military community drowns or is severely injured in an accident while taking part in water sports. The dangers of drinking and operating water and land vehicles (especially motorcycles in heavy, fast-moving traffic) cannot be overemphasized. Personnel must be made aware of the hazards associated with bicycling, camping, hiking, skating and summer outings. Prepare now by doing everything possible to prevent injury and loss of life during the upcoming summer season.
