## Tick Bites Can Cause Lyme Disease

As the warmer weather approaches, so does the risk of tick bites for those involved in outdoor activities. Ticks are often present in dense, mature woods with thick undergrowth of shrubs and small trees, along edges of woods, and where tree lines meet lawns or fields. Community members can protect themselves against tick bites, which can cause Lyme disease, by using a little common sense and taking some prevention measures. While Lyme disease is rarely life threatening, it can cause problems in the heart, joints and nervous system.

People at greatest risk of being bitten by ticks are those who engage in hiking, camping or similar outdoor activities in rural wooded areas. Simple prevention measures to avoid tick bites include wearing light-colored clothing to easily see ticks, tucking in clothing, wearing a tick repellent, avoiding areas with shrubs or tall grass and checking for ticks often while walking through high-risk areas.
