Some Dogs Identified As Aggressive

Dog owners in Stuttgart should be aware of some strict regulations regarding certain breeds and temperaments. The "Law to Control Dangerous Dogs" went into effect April 2001, making it illegal to bring fighting dogs into Germany. This law applies to U.S. Soldiers and civilians. The law pertains to any dog, especially large ones, that tend to be aggressive. Certain breeds have been identified by the German government as having a natural inclination to be aggressive and thus pose a threat to public safety.

Owners of bull terriers, American Staffordshire terriers and pit bull terriers have four weeks upon arrival to register their dogs with an American vet, who will send this information to the German government. Some form of permanent identification on the dog, such as a tattoo or microchip, is required at the time of registration. After the dog is registered, the owner must obtain a Certificate of Need from German authorities, justifying a need to own a fighting dog. Authorities may determine that a dog is aggressive enough to confiscate, impound and possibly destroy. For more info call the U.S. Forces Liaison Office at 0711-819-7329.
