Premium TDY Travel Rule Changes

Changes made to the Joint Travel Regulation stipulate that first class and business government travel are highly restricted. SATO has been instructed to not issue any such tickets unless they are authorized on orders. This applies to rail as well as air travel. All active and reserve military, DoD civilians, accompanying family members and local national civilians on official travel are subject to this policy.

The revised JTR-2 clarifies how premium class travel is to be considered and includes changes to the approval process. The level of authority has changed, and documentation must be reviewed for approval and maintained permanently with the travel order. The "14-hour travel time" rule is no longer an automatic cause for upgrade. Authorization of premium class travel for one family member does not automatically entitle all other family members to premium class travel. Report Suspicious Packages

Community members should be aware of suspicious mail and packages. Characteristics to

look for include an unusual or unknown place of origin, no return address, an excessive amount of postage, threatening messages, an abnormal or unusual size, oily stains or powder, incorrect spelling of common words, differing return address and postmarks and peculiar odors such as almond, dried grass or peach. Never touch or move a suspicious package or letter, and wash hands if you suspect the package might be contaminated. Force Protection Away From Home

When traveling away from home, travel in groups as much as possible. Avoid high-risk areas and demonstrations and keep movement unpredictable. Try to be inconspicuous when using public transportation and facilities. Dress, conduct and mannerisms should not attract attention.
