## Rules for PCS Shipment of Alcohol Changed

Many Americans who start wine collections while in Europe want to send them to the United States when their tours end. However, personnel need to be aware of recent changes in how the Department of the Army reimburses them on shipments of alcohol. Because alcohol cannot be shipped either as part of household goods or through the United States Postal Service, an individual wanting to ship alcohol must find a local commercial exporter to ship his or her collection, and must comply with individual state and Internal Revenue Service rules. Previously, the government reimbursed personnel for the entire cost of that separate shipment, but that has changed. The government will now reimburse personnel only up to the amount it would have cost to ship the same weight of HHGs with a government carrier.
