FEGLI Open Season in Effect

To celebrate this year's 50th anniversary of the Federal Employees' Group Life Insurance Program, the Office of Personnel Management announced that it is conducting a FEGLI open season to Sept. 1. The Benefits Administration Letter 04-203 provides detailed guidance about the FEGLI 2004 open season, at www.opm.gov/asd.

For most federal employees, the earliest that new coverage elected during the FEGLI 2004 open season can be effective is Sept. 4, 2005. The FEGLI 1999 Open Season had a similar delayed effective date, to prevent employees increasing coverage only when they know they need it, resulting in a high number of immediate claims and increased program costs, and that delay worked well. The OPM will share the FE-2004 Open Season Election Form with federal workers when that form is ready.
