Patch Main Gate Work to Reroute Traffic July 20 - 22

The following traffic plan will be implemented for July 20 to 22 at the Patch main gate because of trenching work there. The in-bound lane will be closed and the out-bound lane will be changed to inbound traffic July 20 and 21, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. daily. Each lane will be revert to normal traffic 7 p.m. to 9 a.m. The out-bound lane will be closed for pedestrian crosswalk striping July 22, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., and will reopen to normal traffic at 3 p.m. During the closures all traffic will exit Patch Barracks via the K & K ("back") gate near Montana and Arkansas streets. All Patch units, agencies and activities are requested to reschedule large truck deliveries to reduce traffic flow congestion during these three days.
