Be Careful Buying Insurance and Investments

The Department of Defense warns people not to become victims when purchasing life insurance and financial investments. Community members should be aware of deceptive sales practices by some agents and companies who market combined or separate life insurance and mutual funds. Such deceptive practices include suspicious contacts and approaches, evasive answers, insufficient explanations, and exaggerated or fraudulent claims. Simple precautions such as asking questions, challenging doubtful information, and requiring immediate copies of all signed forms will help keep you from becoming a victim. If an offer seems suspicious it probably is; if it seems too good to be true it probably is. 
