Report Suspected Espionage

Community members can help prevent subversion and espionage by guarding against the collection efforts of foreign intelligence services. Watch for those who attempt to gain information about military missions, activities, equipment, facilities or personnel using unsolicited letters or e-mail, threats, coercion, bribery, trickery, observation, surveillance, document collection or questioning. Report such incidents by calling the Stuttgart Military Intelligence Office, at 421-2206/civ. 0711-729-2206.

Medical Emergency Information

Do not call or report to the Stuttgart Health Clinic for emergencies. It is not staffed or equipped to handle these situations. True emergencies, which may require ambulance service, include heart attack, poisoning, severe bleeding, and unconsciousness, breathing difficulty or severe injury to the head or torso.

If a true emergency exists, on or off post, call the military police at 116/civ. 0711-680-116 and provide the patient's name, age, sex, nature of emergency, your telephone number and location, including installation, street, building, apartment and room number. Stay on the line until instructed to hang up.

The German Red Cross (DRK) provides ambulance service to the Stuttgart military community; the Stuttgart Health Clinic has no ambulances. The DRK should be used for only genuine emergencies to prevent loss of life, limb or vision or to limit undue suffering.
