Medical Emergency Information

Do not call or report to the Stuttgart Health

Clinic for emergencies. The Clinic is not staffed or equipped to handle these situations. True emergencies, which may require ambulance service, include heart attack, poisoning, severe bleeding, unconsciousness, breathing difficulty or severe injury to the head or torso.

If a true emergency exists, on or off post, call the military police at 116/civ. 0711-680-116 and provide the patient's name, age, sex, nature of emergency, and your telephone number and location, (including installation, street, building, apartment and room number). Stay on the line until instructed to hang up.

The German Red Cross (DRK) provides ambulance service to the Stuttgart military community; the Stuttgart Health Clinic has no ambulances. The DRK should be used only for genuine emergencies to prevent loss of life, limb or vision or to limit undue suffering.

SOFA Stamps Required

Family members of active-duty service members stationed in Germany are required to have a new blue Status of Forces Agreement certificate, or SOFA stamp in their no-fee passport no later than Jan. 15, 2005.

The old white certificate will no longer be valid after Jan. 15, 2005. Air Force Personnel should visit Senior Airman Huff in Patch Barracks, bldg. 2308, room 138 or call 430-8459/8429/civ.0711-680-8459/8429. All other military services, DoD
