MEMORANDUM FOR All Personnel Residing within the 6<sup>th</sup> ASG

SUBJECT: 6<sup>th</sup> ASG Command Policy Letter 4, Quiet Hours--Noise Policy

1. In order to allow a full range of activities to all residents of 6<sup>th</sup> Area Support Group communities, and concurrently to guarantee a peaceful environment for our German neighbors and ourselves, we must adhere to quiet hours policy. All loud and disturbing noises, to include skateboarding, inline skating, and playground activities, will cease between 2100 and 0700 from Sunday to Thursday. On Fridays and Saturdays, quiet hours will be observed from 2200 to 0700. This policy is not intended to restrict normal military functions

2. Residents are requested to self-police this policy and parents/sponsors are reminded of their responsibility to monitor closely the activities of their children/guests. The determination of what is "loud and disturbing noise" is subjective in nature and will; therefore, be defined initially by the person who is disturbed.

3. Definition of Loud and Disturbing Noise:


a. Housing Area/ Barracks: Music played loud enough to be heard by a neighbor or person walking outside quarters/barracks room.

b. Vehicle: Music played loud enough to be heard by an adjacent vehicle, pedestrians, or residents in quarters, when windows are open. Car alarms set to go off with surrounding motion and or noise is too sensitive and considered a nuisance.

c. Language: Vulgar, obscene language, whether spoken or contained on tapes, records, cassettes, clothing or other media, is not acceptable in public places, or in barracks and government quarters common areas where others are involuntarily exposed due to location.

4. Residents are encouraged to contact their stairwell, building, area coordinator, or Installation Coordinator to resolve noise problems. As a last resort, contact the Military Police.
