

MEMORANDUM FOR Service Members, Civilian Employees, and Family Members Residing in the 6th ASG Area of Responsibility

SUBJECT: 6th ASG Command Policy Letter 43, Authorization to Drive Privately Owned Vehicles (POVs)/ Rental Vehicles on Stateside Driver's License In Germany

1. REFERENCE: USAREUR Regulation 190-1, Registering and Operating Privately Owned Motor Vehicles in Germany, 8 Jan 04.
2. PURPOSE: To provide procedures for newly arrived personnel requiring an exception/authorization to drive rental vehicles/POVs for a limited time on a stateside driver's license prior to obtaining a USAREUR driver's license. This exception/authorization is intended only for those newly assigned personnel that are unable to obtain their USAREUR driver's license in a timely manner due to mission requirements.
3. Above reference grants the undersigned authority to authorize military and civilian personnel assigned within the 6th ASG area of responsibility to drive POVs and rental vehicles for up to 30 days utilizing a valid stateside driver's license. Individuals desiring to obtain this privilege must contact the 6th ASG Provost Marshal's Office for specific details. The attached application should be completed by the requestor and forwarded through the individual's commander to the undersigned for approval.
4. The enclosed application includes specific instructions/directions that must be adhered to, which validate this request and my approval. I strongly recommend individuals attend driver's training and obtain a USAREUR driver's license as soon as possible to become familiar with host nation differences in driving and to contribute to the prevention of motor vehicle accidents.
