

### Driving Too Fast For Conditions!



#### Suspected Causal Factors

- Speed – Too fast for conditions.
- Overconfidence in driving ability.

A soldier operating a very powerful motorcycle, passed a vehicle in excess of 100 MPH. He lost control of the motorcycle, left the roadway, impacted a road marker, a sign, and a concrete culvert. The ensuing impact caused serious injuries to the soldier including the loss of one arm. The soldier did not have a valid U.S. Forces Class 1 motorcycle license.
