
SUBJECT: USAG Stuttgart Policy Letter #34, Dining Facility Open Door Policy

1. REFERENCES: AR 30-22, Para 3-1g and 3-34, The Army Food Program, 10 June 2005 and AE Reg 550-175, Para 11 d. (2), 24 January 2003.
2. PURPOSE: To provide policy and procedures pertaining to personnel authorized to subsist in the USAG Stuttgart consolidated community dining facilities.
3. Service members assigned to a USAG Installation may consume meals in any dining facility. If a group of ten or more soldiers from any command is assigned duty at any of the other installations, the commander is responsible for informing the losing and gaining dining facility of the change of support.
4. Family members and Department of the Army Civilians (DAC) employees may consume occasional meals in the USAG Stuttgart dining facilities. Family members and DAC employees will pay the applicable meal rate. Family members of E-4's and below will pay the discounted meal rate. Military and DAC ID cards must be in your possession at the headcount station.
5. DAC employees requiring meals on a continuous basis will request approval to subsist in writing through my office. Approval is normally granted only when commercial or non-appropriated fund facilities are not available or duty assignment precludes departure from the duty area.
6. Local National Civilians who work on U.S. Forces installations may consume food and beverages in snackbars, clubs, or other U.S. Forces catering facilities without paying duties and taxes to German custom authorities on those days that they are actually working. LN employees are not allowed to bring their families or guests to U.S. Forces catering facilities for the purpose of dining there. Local Nationals authorized to consume a meal in the dining facility will sign DD Form 1544, Cash Meal Payment Sheet, and pay the appropriate meal rate.
7. This memorandum is to be posted in all the USAG Stuttgart Dining Facilities Headcount SOPs.
